

## **Arctic Orienteering Club - Women's O**

Held at Alaska Pacific University

Wednesday, July 11, 2007

Forty-six women and girls participated in the club's first women-only orienteering event. Jen Jolliff prevailed in the individual class, earning 360 out of 480 possible points. Reinet Arnett and Julie Sharp-Dahl topped the other teams with a total of 280 out of 480 possible points.

This was a staggered-start score-O. Each person or team had 45 minutes to find as many of the 24 controls as possible. Each was worth 10, 20 or 30 points (the value depending on distance from the start and difficulty of finding the control), for a total of 480 possible points. The penalty for taking more than 45 minutes was 10 points per minute or fraction of a minute.
